
### Venue

The meeting will be held at St John's College, University of Oxford, located on St Giles in the centre of Oxford. The college offers excellent conference facilities, including onsite accommodation. There will be an informal reception at the Museum of the History of Science on the Wednesday evening. The conference dinner will be held in St John's College's historic dining hall on Thursday evening.

# **Scientific Programme**

The meeting will follow the format of previous years, with a satellite workshop (entitled *Diffusion Tractography: Revealing the Architecture of the Human Brain*) during the afternoon of 31 August. The main scientific sessions will combine lectures from invited expert speakers with scientific presentations. To encourage participation from clinicians and radiographers, the final day (Friday) will have an increased clinical focus and a special Friday-only programme registration is available. (Please note that Thursday-only registration is not available). Featured sessions will include: Experimental Models, MR Safety, Sequence Design and Data Analysis, Cardiovascular and Angiographic MR, Advanced Neuro MR, Body and Musculoskeletal MR, Novel Contrast Agents and Molecular MR. The Royal College of Radiology has awarded 11 Category I (external) CPD credits for the scientific meeting (5 for Thursday 1 September and 6 for Friday 2 September).

It should be emailed, with your name and the abstract title in the email subject line, to bcismrm@fmrib.ox.ac.uk. Electronic versions only please. Abstracts should include: title, authors and affiliations, introduction, methods, results and conclusions. Figures will be reproduced in greyscale. Please state in the email whether you prefer an oral or poster presentation. Note that copyright to accepted abstracts becomes the property of BCISMRM, and abstracts may be posted on the BCISMRM website (behind password protection). The deadline for abstracts is 15 July 2005.

# **Travelling to Oxford**

Oxford is 57 miles west of London with good rail (via London Paddington) and coach (the Oxford Tube and the Oxford Citybus X90) services to the capital. Heathrow and Gatwick airports are linked to Oxford via the Oxford Citybus X70 service, which runs every 30 minutes between Oxford and Heathrow and every 60 minutes between Oxford and Gatwick.
