

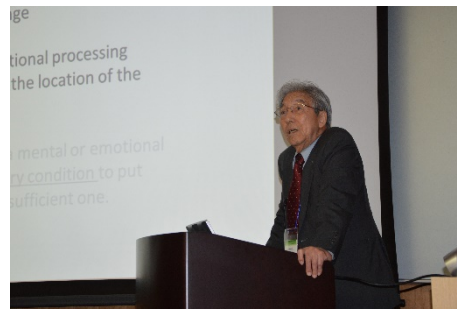


The 1st Annual Scientific Meeting of the ISMRM Japanese Chapter
