**Peter Luijten, Ph.D.** is the Professor of Functional Imaging at University Medical Centre Utrecht and Chief Scientific Officer at the Centre for Translational Molecular Medicine. Dr. Luijten has worked as a research scientist at Philips

Medical Systems, where he developed multiple new technologies resulting in several patents and peer reviewed journal articles. He has served on the Board of Trustees of the International Society of Magnetic Resonance in Medicine and was appointed Fellow of the society in 1995. He is the recipient of the 2002 European Magnetic Resonance Award for Basic Science. Dr. Luijten will speak on *Clinical Applications of Multinuclear MR Spectroscopy*, *Neuro Imaging at 7 Tesla*, and *MR Guided Interventions*.



**Guenther Schneider, M.D., Ph.D.** is the Professor of Radiology at the Saarland University Medical Centre, Homburg, Germany. Dr. Schneider is the author of several books and peer reviewed articles covering many areas of Clinical Magnetic Resonance Imaging.

He has particular interests in fast body imaging and liver MRI, as well as paediatric imaging applications. Dr. Schneider will present on *Fast Liver Imaging Techniques*, *Paediatric Abdominal Tumour Staging*, and *Dynamic Contrast Enhancement Imaging*.
